Why?

What?

- Social Security number
- Income
- Account balances and assets

When you are no longer our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
	Our affiliates include companies with the common corporate identity of Country Club Financial Services Inc.: financial companies such as CCB Financial Corporation, Country Club Bank and Asset Management Group.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
	Country Club Financial Services Inc. does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.

Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.
